

Drugs that may raise potassium

- ACE inhibitors
- ARBs
- Selective Aldosterone Receptor Antagonists (e.g. eplerenone)
- Trimethoprim – sulfamethoxazole
- NSAIDs
- Beta Blockers
- Potassium-sparing diuretics (e.g. amiloride or spironolactone)
- Antifungals (e.g. fluconazole)
